DISCOVERY ZONE

Full of free activities to explore for children (& adults) of all ages! Get hands on, interactive and learn more about farming, food and the countryside!



MILITARY AREA

There are lots of fun activities to get involved with for all ages from assault courses to fitness tests. Speak to Service men and women about careers in the armed forces.



VETSPEC

COUNTRYSIDE PURSUITS AREA

Showcasing the best of the countryside. From fly fishing competitions in the ponds to gun dog demonstrations in the arena.



SHEEP

Watch world-class sheep shearers and take a walk through the sheep pens to see the variety of breeds competing for champion status.



PIGS & GOATS

Learn all about pig breeds and get to know your Gloucestershire Old Spots from your British Saddlebacks, see them up close and ask the experts any questions you may have. Visit the Goat Building to discover which breeds are best for producing dairy and which produce the best meat.

CATTLE RINGS
