

# BEEF CATTLE: READ ME BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR ENTRY FORM

## Main Changes for 2022:

No Mid-week changeover this year / BVD Testing  
Show Opening times: 8am - 6pm on all 4 days

Tuesday - British Charolais, Beef Shorthorn & Commercial Beef

Wednesday - All other Beef Breeds

Thursday - Dairy Breeds

## BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHOEA (BVD) - See Reg. 56

Exhibitors entering cattle will be required to demonstrate that either individual animals have been tested for the presence of BVD virus (with negative results) or that the animal originates or resides in a herd accredited BVD free on a CHeCS approved cattle scheme. Proof will require a copy of a relevant laboratory report (including 'Tag and Test') or details of a BVD scheme membership. These documents must be presented at the Livestock Registration Office on arrival.

## CATTLE AREA WRISTBANDS

Each exhibitor can have a maximum of 3 cattle area wristbands which will enable people access to the cattle sheds. If required, these can be collected from RAC Reception at the Show. Please note they do NOT gain access to the Show.

**ENTRIES**- Please complete the entry form and list the class numbers that you wish to enter; this should include any pairs or group entries. **Entries close 5pm Tuesday 10th May.**

An email will be sent to you confirming your classes on Tuesday 14th June; at this point you will have until 5pm on Friday 17th June to make any changes to the classes you have listed. Changes should be made in writing/email (and confirmation of receipt of changes must be obtained from the office).

**Please note** we will not be recording the animal data again this year, as this provides you the exhibitor with the maximum flexibility and because of this change to the entry format, entry fees will only be refunded if you are cancelling the entire entry for either animal health reasons or for personal reasons; every full cancellation would be considered on an individual basis.

**STALLS** – **These can only be booked on the entry form.** This year, the Great Yorkshire Show will host the World Congress Shows for British Charolais and Shorthorn Societies. This will impact on stall bookings so please book your stalls early to avoid disappointment. **STALLS ARE LIMITED TO 4 PER BREED PER EXHIBITOR.** If you want your cattle to be stalled next to a specific exhibitor (**must be same breed**), please write this on your cattle entry form or attach a note to the form – a phone call to the office is not sufficient. *Re Stall allowance for World Congress Shows, see individual breeds.*

**STALL CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS** - Your written/email/ cancellation instruction should be received by the Livestock & Entries Office **before 5pm Friday 17 June** in order to receive a full refund for a stall so that we can offer the stall to any exhibitors who may be on the waiting list. Stall cancellations requested after this time/date will be considered for a 50% refund; stall deposit refunds after this time/date will be looked at on an individual basis.

**THE CATTLE STALLING PLAN** - This plan is designed to ensure the timely, safe and most efficient movement of animals from the stalls to the showing rings. Please do not move or change exhibitor cards that have been put above stalls as this causes several types of difficulty and much ill-feeling for other exhibitors. Anyone found to have moved cards may be subject to future restrictions.

**AGE OF HANDLERS** - handlers in the breed classes **MUST BE OVER 14 YEARS OF AGE.** Handlers in the young handler classes **must be supervised by an experienced adult handler** who is able to restrain/control the animal in an emergency – see Reg. 65

**CLIPPING CRATES** - **Clipping Crates will not be allowed in any of the sheds.** A clipping area has been established for a limited number of crates. Any exhibitor wishing to bring a clipping crate must register their interest in writing/email to the Livestock Office for approval. Unapproved crates will have to be removed immediately by the exhibitor from the Showground.

## **ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT IN CATTLE HOUSING** - See Reg. 80

Fridges/freezers and ALL cooking equipment are **NOT** permitted in the cattle sheds or marquees. *These can possibly be housed in your Breed Offices if necessary but you will need to liaise with your Breed Society to organise this before the Show.*

## **GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS**

At this time we are hopeful that all Covid restrictions will be lifted at Show time but we will obviously be governed by the guidelines at the time to ensure we put on a safe show for all concerned.

**Exhibitor Wristband Allocation**

Exhibitor wristbands will be allocated on the basis of **two** wristbands per animal entered, up to a maximum of **six** wristbands (if eligible).

**STALL DEPOSIT SYSTEM**

YAS has implemented a deposit fee system of £50 per stall booked.

The deposit fee will be refunded after Show via BACS to those exhibitors whose pre-booked stalls are occupied by their pre-booked cattle and not tack.

**Animals entered in the Beef Classes must be in the Show-ground no later than 6pm on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July and remain in the Showground until close of Show on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July.**
