

# DAIRY CATTLE: Read Me before completing the entry form

## Major Changes for 2022:

No mid-week changeover this year / BVD Testing

Show Opening Times: 8am - 6pm on all 4 days

### Bovine Viral Diarrhoea (BVD) - See Reg 56.

Exhibitors entering cattle will be required to demonstrate that either individual animals have been tested for the presence of BVD virus (with negative results) or that the animal originates or resides in a herd accredited BVD free on a CHeCS approved cattle scheme. Proof will require a copy of a relevant laboratory report (including 'Tag and Test') or details of a BVD scheme membership. These documents must be presented at the Livestock Registration Office on arrival.

### CATTLE AREA WRISTBANDS

Each exhibitor can have a maximum of 3 cattle area wristbands which will enable people access to the cattle sheds. These can be collected from RAC Reception at the Show. Please note they do NOT gain access to the Show.

### STALL BOOKING FORM - close date Tuesday 10 May 2022

Stalls are limited to 4 per breed per exhibitor and allocated on a first-come-first served basis. If you would like your animals to be stalled next to another exhibitor - who are showing the same breed – please make this clear on the stall booking form. Telephone requests will not be recorded. Re Stall allowance for World Congress Shows, see individual breeds.

### STALL DEPOSIT SYSTEM

The deposit will be refunded **VIA BACS** to exhibitors whose pre-booked stall/s are occupied by their pre-booked cattle and not tack etc. Please ensure your BACS details are on the stall booking and Dairy Detail Forms.

### DAIRY CLASS ENTRY FORM & YOUNG HANDLER FORM

These forms will be emailed out before Tuesday 7th June to exhibitors who have booked stalls. Dairy class entry forms together with full payment and a copy of each animal registration document must be received in Livestock & Entries Office by 5pm on **Thursday 7th July**.

With the exception of the Blythewood Pairs, entries into the Pairs & Groups cannot be made on the day, so please add and pay for these on your class entry form.

**Milk Payment** - This payment will now be 20 pence per litre and will be paid by bank transfer.

**AGE OF HANDLERS** Handlers in the breed or commercial classes must be **OVER 14 years of age**. In the Younger handler classes they must be supervised by an experienced adult handler who is able to restrain/control the animal in an emergency - See Rg. 65.

### The Stalling Plan

The stalling plan is designed to ensure the timely and most efficient movement of animals from the stalls to the showing rings. **Please do not move or change exhibitor cards that have been put above stalls as this causes several types of difficulty and ill-feeling for other exhibitors. Anyone found to have moved cards may be subject to future restrictions.**

### Malpractice – see Reg. 66

The Society has decided that lactating cattle at this year's Great Yorkshire Show may be subject to an ultrasound examination; this will be performed by a veterinary surgeon.

N.B. Scanning of lactating cattle could take place on both Thursday and Friday of Show.

**Clipping Crates** - Clipping crates will not be allowed in the sheds. A new clipping area has been established. Any exhibitor wishing to bring a clipping crate must apply in writing to the Livestock Office for approval.

### Electrical Equipment In Cattle Housing - See Reg. 80

Fridges/freezers and ALL cooking equipment are NOT permitted in the cattle sheds or marquees. These can possibly be housed in your Breed Offices if necessary but you will need to liaise with your Breed Society to organise this before the Show.

## CARAVANS & MOTORHOMES

Caravans/Motorhomes can be brought to the Show after 2pm on Friday 9 July. Only one car space is allowed per caravan as space is limited. Exhibitors must vacate the park by noon on Saturday 16 July.

A Caravan permit (£80.00) or a motorhome permit (£80.00) must be purchased on your stall booking form if you wish to bring a caravan or motorhome to the Show. This cost is for the duration of the Show regardless of the number of nights occupied.

Please indicate if you have a family and wish to use the Family 'Quiet' Zone. Pitches are limited so bookings will be on a first come first served basis.

**The permit should be displayed at all times as the parks will be regularly monitored for caravans and motorhomes without permits.**

### SLEEPING IN YOUR WAGON – FREE OF CHARGE

Please indicate on the stall booking form if you intend sleeping in your trailer/wagon. This will enable us to park you safely.

## STALL DEPOSIT SYSTEM

Following several complaints from exhibitors that there were empty stalls in the sheds, or stalls being used for tack, it has been decided to implement a refundable deposit fee system per stall booked, i.e £50.00 deposit.

**The deposit fee will be refunded AFTER SHOW via BACS Payment** to Exhibitors whose booked stalls are occupied by their pre-booked cattle and not used for tack.
