



Dunnington-Jefferson House - accommodation Great Yorkshire Show, Tuesday 14 – Friday 17 July 2026

The Yorkshire Agricultural Society has limited on-site accommodation for our livestock exhibitors at the Great Yorkshire Show. **Dunnington-Jefferson House is for use solely by exhibitors/stockmen (over the age of 18) at the show. We ask that all interested parties send an 'Expression of Interest' form to be eligible for the ballot. Closing date for forms to be received is Friday 1 May 2026**

Below are details of the accommodation block and booking process:

D. J. House offers 10 twin rooms (maximum 2 occupants) and 60 single rooms (maximum 1 occupant), each with basic furniture, bed and mattress (**residents must supply their own bedding**). Shower, toilets and clothes drying facilities are in the same building and are available **only to residents**. **For 2026, DJ House residents will be expected to wear a resident wristband AT ALL TIMES. Failure to do so will exclude you for accessing the building.**

All rooms are lockable, and a Warden will be in attendance. **Please note that this accommodation is unsuitable for anyone under the age of eighteen.** Check-in is from 2pm Saturday 11 July and checkout before 12 noon Saturday 18 July.

A maximum of one **TWIN (£330)** OR two **SINGLE (£165 each)** rooms can be booked per exhibitor/family so that as many individual exhibitors can be accommodated. Caravan permits may still be booked with your livestock entry (availability permitting).

As these rooms are extremely popular, a ballot system is in place. After the closing date, we will hold a ballot and contact the successful applicants. The ballot takes into account applications received across all Livestock sections and travelling distance from the showground.

Successful applications: We will contact all successful applicants as soon as possible after the closing date, to take payment in full. However, all unsuccessful applicants will be added to a waiting list in the event of any cancellations. If you have not been contacted for payment by 15 May 2026, it means you have not been successful and are on a waiting list for cancellations.

If you don't receive an acknowledgement of your emailed form within 48 hours, please contact us as we may have not received it.

If you need to cancel your booking please write/email the Department, no later than 5pm Friday 29th May, so that we can offer the room to someone on the waiting list and process a full refund to you providing the room can be resold. If a cancellation request is received after this date any payment made becomes non refundable.
