Accessible Parking & Drop Off Point

Sainsbury's car park, off the A661 Wetherby Road, is the designated accessible parking area, offering easy access to the Orange Gate and a drop-off/pick-up point just outside the entrance. Local authority permits (Blue Badges) or Great Yorkshire Show accessible parking labels should be clearly displayed.

Blue badge holders do not require a GYS label. Parking spaces cannot be reserved in advance and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If this car park becomes full, additional accessible parking will be provided in alternative areas.

Please follow the signage with the  symbol.



Coaches

Coaches wishing to use the drop-off / pick-up point should follow the directions above then follow the signs to the coach park where every effort will be made to park them as close to an entrance as possible.

Shortage of space means regrettably, we cannot allow coaches to park in the Accessible Car Park.



Wheelchair and Scooter Service

To support visitors who require mobility assistance, Advanced Mobility provides a wheelchair and electric scooter hire service at the Show. The hire point is located on Third Avenue near the Orange Entrance..

Walkways and Access

Most walkways on the Showground are made of concrete, asphalt or gravel. Many buildings and the routes to the animal areas are ramped or accessible for wheelchair and mobility scooter users.

We also work to ensure that grass avenues are well rolled to support easier movement around the Show.

Please be aware that the Showground has some sloping areas, which may require additional effort for manual wheelchair users, particularly when travelling to and from the car parks, which are mainly on grass.



Grandstand

Limited accessible viewing platforms are available at either end of the Grandstand.

These spaces are free of charge and do not need to be reserved in advance; they are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis each day from the Grandstand Ticket Office.

For safety reasons, wheelchairs cannot be accommodated in the aisles of any seating areas in line with fire regulations. An admission charge of £10 applies for all other reserved seating within the Grandstand.

First Aid

Medical assistance is provided by **Medics UK**, with the **Medical Centre** located near **White Gate** (marked First Aid on Showground maps). Paramedic ambulances, as well as foot and cycle responders, are stationed throughout the Showground for quick assistance.

Maps with medical locations will be available during your visit.



Toilets And Baby Changing Facilities

Showground toilets include **accessible toilet facilities and baby changing areas**, all of which are clearly marked on the maps available during your visit. Our stewards and contractors regularly monitor these facilities to maintain cleanliness throughout the day.



Changing Places Facility

A fully equipped Changing Places facility is available in Hall 2, providing additional space and specialist equipment for visitors who require it. The facility includes a height-adjustable adult-sized changing bench and a hoist, offering a safe and comfortable environment for those who need more room or support during personal care.

If you would like to use this facility, please speak to our team at the Information Point in Hall 1 and they will be happy to arrange access for you.

Disabled Visitors & Carer Tickets

Carer tickets no longer need to be arranged in advance. All visitors (except carers) must purchase an entry ticket online at greatyorkshireshow.co.uk or via the **ticket hotline 01423 541222** (9am–5pm, Mon–Fri).

Tickets are subject to availability.

Carers accompanying a visitor who requires support can receive free entry on the day.

To qualify, please present one of the following at the gate:

- A Valid Blue Badge
- An Access Card with the 1 symbol
- A Letter confirming DLA, PIP, Attendance Allowance, or Carer's Allowance
- Incapacity Benefit confirmation, or
- A Certificate of Visual Impairment (CVI) or BD8
